## Downloading the Driver

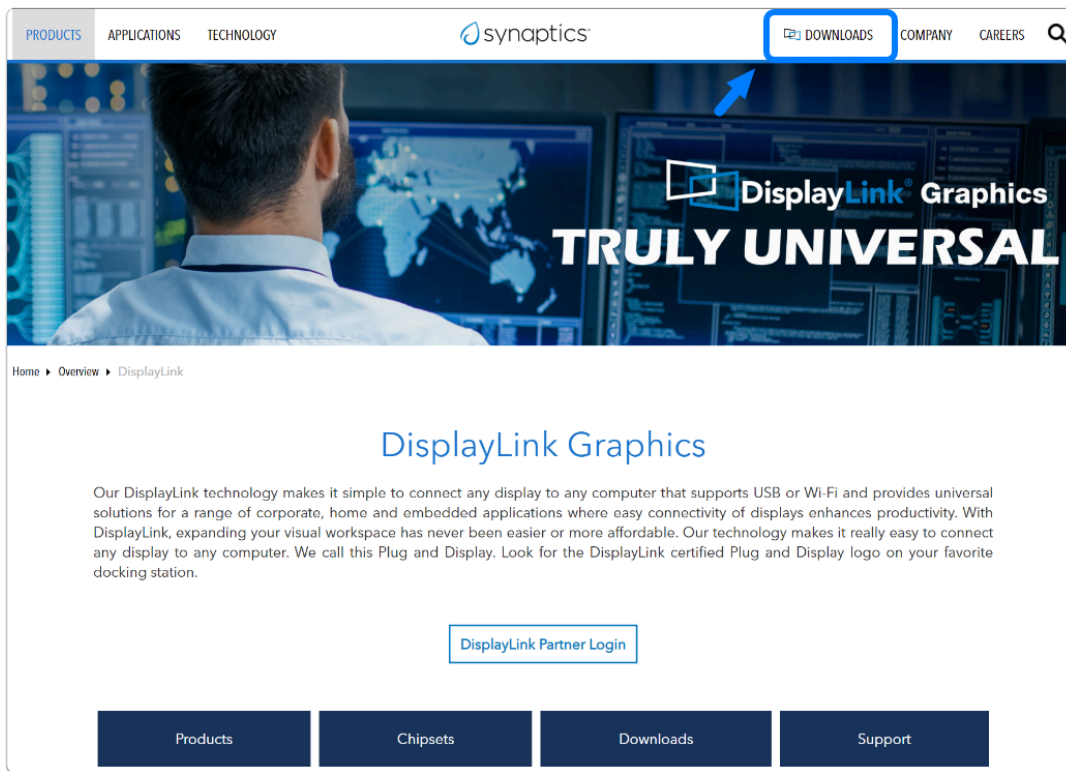
### 1. Go to the DisplayLink Website

Open your preferred web browser and go to [DisplayLink.com](https://www.displaylink.com)

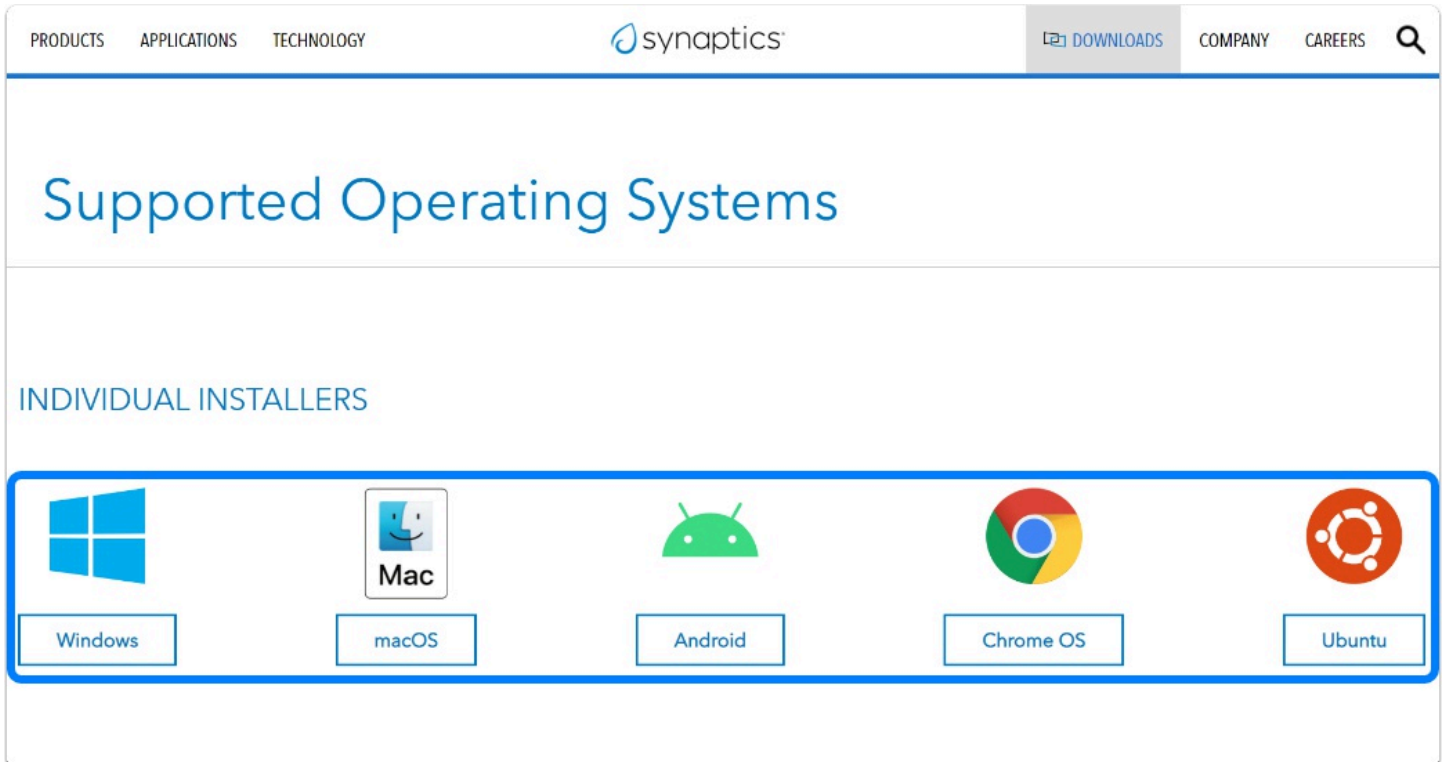
### 2. Download the Driver



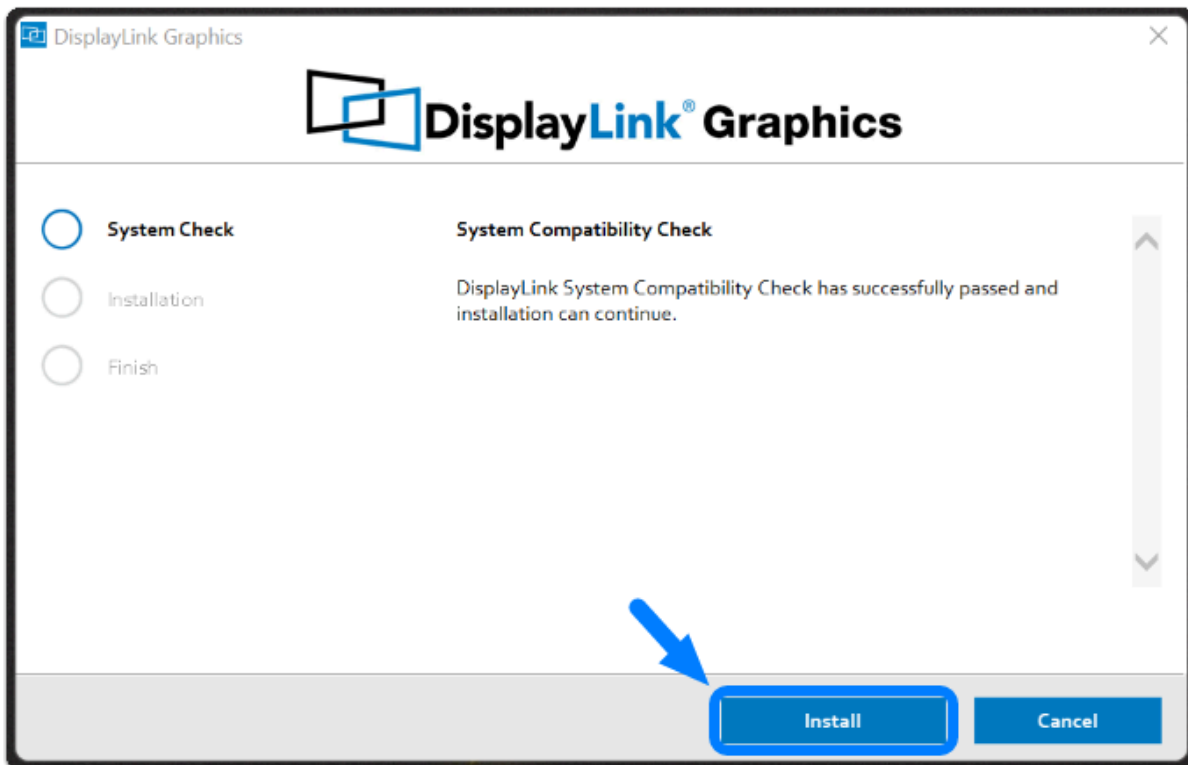

## Installing the Driver

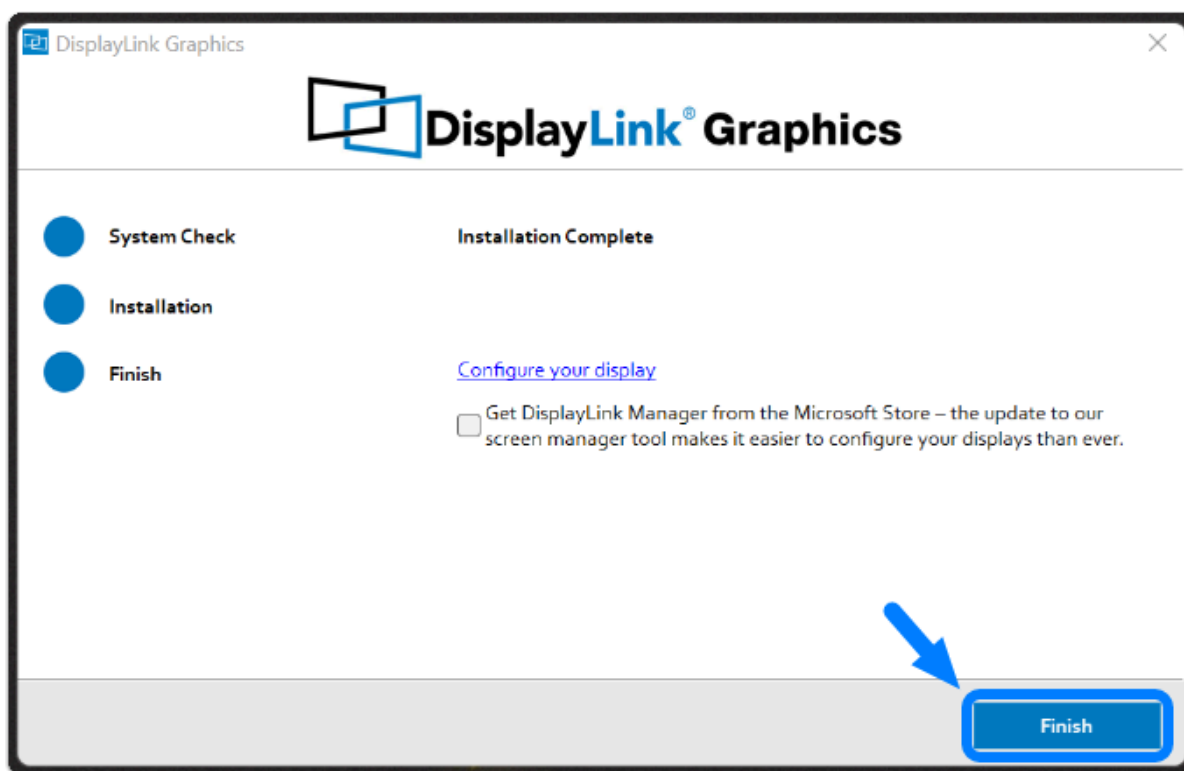
**1. Open the file that was Downloaded from the website**
